"Bluebirds" by Crabapple Hill is the project and everyone is closing in on the end.

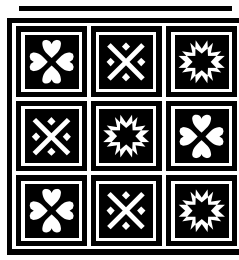
The Farmer's Wife group meets once a month on Tuesday.
